

# Preservation I-84 – Tree Removal

(Riverdale Road/SR-26 to US-89)

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is scheduled to begin a preservation project on Interstate 84 (I-84), with the initial work in the Uintah and South Weber area on February 11. As part of this preservation project, UDOT crews will be removing trees on UDOT property along I-84 in Uintah and South Weber.

## OVERVIEW

- The tree removal portion of this project is scheduled to begin February 11 and is expected to be complete by the end of the month.
- Construction work on I-84 from Riverdale Road to US-89 is projected to begin April 1, and be completed by late this summer.
- Work will occur Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- The trees are being removed due to the damage they sustained from the 2017 wildfire. The damage to the trees was extensive enough that they need to be removed for safety reasons.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

- Motorists can expect lane closures in tree removal areas along I-84 from Riverdale Road to US-89.
- Motorists should expect delays of approximately 15 minutes during work hours.
- Sunday work may occur occasionally throughout the project – please check the project website for updates.
- **Dates and times of construction are subject to change based on weather and equipment availability.**
- **Please travel slowly through the construction zone and follow posted signs.**
