## **Mayor's Message**

Hello again, good residents of South Weber,

I wanted to make you aware of some major construction coming up this spring/summer. UDOT is going to mill and overlay the entire South Weber Drive corridor this year. Of course the whole road will not be under construction at the same time, but be aware that delays will be possible along that route for the majority of the summer. There will also be construction going on at 475 E. next to Old Fort Road and on the bridge over I-84.

These are all necessary and awesome projects, so please be patient, drive cautiously, and plan ahead to avoid delays.

I also wanted to give you an update on trail accommodations crossing HWY 89. I have met multiple times with UDOT and the contractors for the upcoming US 89; Farmington to I-84 project. UDOT is desirous to accommodate a trail either under the Weber River bridges on HWY 89 or further south with a box culvert under the highway. This box culvert would be about 16' wide and 12' high to give access to maintenance vehicles traveling to Dominion station just west of the highway; it would also be lighted. The improvements for a trail accommodation are contingent upon the amount of funds awarded to the US 89 project by the Utah Transportation Commission and Utah State Legislature.

Finally, I would like to address concerns about Canyon Meadows Park. The South Weber Parks and Rec Committee has targeted Canyon Meadows as their top priority for park improvements. Unfortunately, the City cannot proceed with any improvements to this park until the Army Corps of Engineers has signed off on our Wetlands Delineation Study and determined that there are no wetlands in this area that need to be preserved. We have been working to complete this study for the past 6-8 months, but the corps wants to view the area at the time of Spring runoff before they approve the land for park development.

## Snow Removal

Residents, please do not shovel/blow snow into the street. Piles of snow on roads create frozen bumps that contribute to car crashes and are dangerous for our drivers if the plow hits one. They also have the potential to create draining problems, drifting sight obstruction and hindered accessibility. Snow blown or shoveled back onto roads also slows down the work South Weber plows have to do in the wake of a storm.

Here is a list regarding snow removal responsibilities:

### South Weber City

*Snow removal operations will begin with snow accumulations of 1" or less.*

- A. Major Collector Streets
  - a. 475 East
  - b. 1900 East
  - c. 2100 East
  - d. Deer Run Drive
  - e. Highway 89 Frontage Roads
- B. Minor Collector Streets-all other city owned streets
- C. Cul-de-sacs
- D. Sidewalks traversing all city owned properties



### UDOT

*Snow removal operations begin with snow accumulations of at least 1"/hr. keeping at least one travel lane in each direction.*

- A. Major Collector Street
  - a. South Weber Drive

### Home Owner

*As a homeowner, snow removal is required within 24 hours after the end of a snowfall.*

- A. Responsibilities
  - a. Sidewalks in front of and along the sides of the home
  - b. Adjacent Mailboxes
  - c. Adjacent Fire Hydrants



*The Park & Ride is contracted through a third-party company.*

The City does not have a bare asphalt snow removal policy; however, operations will continue until roads are passable. Safety of the plow operators and the public is important. Therefore, snowplowing/removal operations may be terminated after 12 to 14 hours to allow City Personnel adequate time for recovery. Operations may also be suspended during time periods of limited visibility, significant winds, or drifting snow to not jeopardize the safety of City Employees and equipment.
