Code Enforcement Reminders: NO DOGS IN THE PARKS, WHETHER THEY'RE ON A LEASH OR NOT!

Also, remember that according to SWC Code 7.01.030 it is "...unlawful for any person owning, occupying or having control of any premise to place or permit to be placed upon or in the sidewalk, parking area, gutter or on the half of the street next to such premises: refuse (such as grass clippings, garbage, ashes and other like things), building materials, or structures." For safety, please keep our streets and sidewalks clear!

MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

There will be a municipal general election on November 7, 2017 for the following offices:

- 1 Mayoral position (4-year term)
- 2 At-Large City Council positions (4-year term) If a primary election is needed, it will be held on August 15, 2017.

The constitutional and statutory qualification requirements for municipal office are:

- 1. The person is a registered voter in the municipality.
- 2. The person will be at least 18 years old at the time of the next election.
- 3. The person is a legal resident of the municipality for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
- 4. The person has not been convicted of a felony.

Interested parties may declare their candidacy for an office in person between June 1 and June 7, 2017, at City Hall with the City Recorder located at 1600 E. South Weber Dr., Monday - Friday between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM. More information can be found on the City's website.

2017-2018 TENTATIVE BUDGET ADOPTED

The tentative budget for 2017-2018 was adopted by the City Council on May 9, 2017. The budget is available for public review on our website www.southwebercity.com and at City Hall. A public hearing on the Adopted Tentative Budget will be held June 13, 2017 at City Hall. A second public hearing will be held the same night to open and amend the 2016-2017 Budget. The 2017-18 Final budget will then be adopted in an open meeting of the City Council on June 20, 2017 at City Hall.

Dear South Weber Resident's,

You are a key participant in helping the Davis County Sheriff's Office keep our community safe. The One Hundred Deadliest Days of Traffic Related Deaths started Memorial Weekend. Davis County Sheriff's Deputies are asking that we all slow down in our daily commutes, especially in our neighborhoods. Remember to stop for stop signs, failing to stop is a significant factor in auto-pedestrian accidents; distracted driving, failure to stay in your lane, and failure to signal are common causes of traffic accidents; and SPEED is the single most contributing factor to debilitating traumatic injuries and death in vehicle accidents. So, please slow down because each time you get behind the wheel to drive, people's lives are at risk, including your own.

GREAT JOB! Last month, a South Weber citizen's report of a suspicious person in South Weber City led to an arrest for theft and warrants with property, a vehicle, returned to the rightful owner. Please don't hesitate to call if you see or sense something suspicious.

The street conditions in South Weber City are failing to meet expected service levels. With each passing year, the integrity of the City's roads decreases.






46% of the roads in South Weber City have a remaining service life of 6 years or less. Current City revenues cannot support the infrastructural demands for street maintenance.
