<p>South Weber City Code 10-11-3: MAIN AND ACCESSORY BUILDINGS: E. Private Swimming Pool And Tennis Court Location: A private outside swimming pool or tennis court may be constructed as an accessory use to a main building within the side or rear yard thereof; provided, that it is set back from the side and rear lot lines not less than four feet (4') and not less than thirty feet (30') from any neighbor's dwelling. When an adjacent lot is vacant, a swimming pool or tennis court must be located at least fifteen feet (15') from any side lot line of any neighboring lot. Where a swimming pool is completely enclosed in a building, the location requirements for accessory and main buildings shall apply. Where any swimming pool is to be located in the near vicinity of any septic tank or sewage disposal field, the location of the same shall first be approved by the Davis County Health Department. Swimming pools shall be completely fenced with a fence suitable for preventing accidental human entry into the pool area and at least four feet (4') high.
