

Agenda Item: Fiber to the Premises (FTTP) - A Work Session Discussion

**Background:** South Weber City held a <u>work session</u> on Tuesday, September 21, 2021 to discuss the responses received to the City's published Request for Information (RFI) for Fiber to the Premises (FTTP). During the meeting, the City Council expressed a desire to bring additional high speed broadband options to the City and leaned toward a subscriber model of delivery where only those who subscribe to the service would pay for it. They also scheduled this follow up work session meeting for today, October 5, 2021, to hear from the short-listed companies that could provide the service following the principles expressly desired.

Connext, STRATA, and UTOPIA will have representatives in attendance to present their potential solutions and answer any questions the Council may have.
