Code Enforcement Notes

Welcome to the season of solicitors! If you have a solicitor come to your door, please ensure that they have a current South Weber City badge. A South Weber City Solicitor's badge must always be worn in plain sight. Prior to a solicitor receiving a badge, it is required by law for them to have had a background check done. Please contact City Hall at 801-479-3177 or speak with Code Enforcement at the number below if you have any questions.

Over the last year, we have had a large increase in complaints about dogs being in the parks, and those complaints are very difficult to follow up on without help. Please feel free to contact Code Enforcement at 801-540-7094. To issue a citation through the courts, there must be proof of the animal being in an unauthorized park. To avoid citation, please keep in mind that a new dog park has opened on 2020 E just off Deer Run Drive.

Fire Department

Here are a few safety tips from our Fire Department on Fireworks Safety:

- Use fireworks outdoors only.
- Obey local laws.
- Always have water handy.
- Only use fireworks as intended. DO NOT try to alter them or combine them.
- Never re-light a "dud" firework (wait 20 minutes and then soak it in a bucket of water).
- Use common sense when using fireworks. Spectators should keep a safe distance from the fireworks. The person lighting the fireworks should wear safety glasses.
- Alcohol and fireworks do not mix! Have a "designated" person light fireworks
- Only persons over age 12 should be allowed to handle sparklers of any type.
- **DO NOT** ever use homemade fireworks or illegal explosives; they can kill! Report illegal explosives to the fire department (801-476-8907), or sheriff's office (801-444-2280).

South Weber City has its own restrictions that can be found on the Fire Department's Facebook page, as well as the city's.
