Dear Good Citizens of South Weber,

Spring is upon us! It is my second favorite season of the year. I know some of you have been dealing with gravel in your driveways and mow strips due to the chip and seal projects we did last year. Please have patience and know that, despite the mess, these projects will greatly increase the life of our roads.

And now, here is a special report for all of you dog enthusiasts! There is a new residential development taking place this spring just east and south of the Posse Grounds. A portion of that property (nearly 4

acres) has been donated to the City as part of this project. Nilson Homes has agreed to improve the detention basin in that area with grass and sprinklers as well as to fence it for use as a dog park. They have also agreed to put a trail around the perimeter of the entire area. They will begin construction on these facilities with their first phase of construction this summer. We created a dog park last year in another area in the City, and though it was not ideally located, we found that it was very well used, and we understand the need for a permanent dog park. The citizens who used the dog park last summer tried to be very respectful of the neighbors and were good to clean up after their dogs. I am confident this type of respect will continue at the new location.

Finally, I am pleased to announce that Carlos Braceras, Executive Director of UDOT, has commited to putting a box culvert under HWY 89 just south of Weber River to accommodate a trail with the US-89: Farmington to I-84 construction project that will begin next summer! This trail connection will eventually hook up the Bonneville Shoreline Trail in Layton with the Bonneville Shoreline Trail in South Ogden and with the Weber River Trail in South Weber. This is a huge accomplishment for our City, and we have worked very hard for the past couple of years to see it to fruition. This announcement is particularly significant as the freeway portion of the US-89 project was significantly underfunded and might only be constructed as far north as Antelope Drive or SR-193.

I hope you all enjoy the beautiful spring weather!!!

Code Enforcement

As the spring season approaches, so does the growth of unwanted weeds. City Code states that weeds over 6" in height are a fire hazard and a nuisance, and property owners can be cited for failure of removal (Code 4-2-7). Please help us in keeping our city clean and safe for all of our residents by removing your weeds in a timely manner. Thank you!

Fire Department

Fireworks season is quickly approaching. We will be having the same restrictions as last year and will post the map in the May and June Newsletters as well as on our facebook page; or you can find them on our website. This map will be strictly enforced by our police and fire departments due to our annual extreme fire conditions here in the area. For a rapid emergency response, our Fire Station is staffed with 2 firefighters 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Permission is required prior to having any outdoor fires (excluding grills). This serves several purposes including complaints that we receive from other citizens, and for documentation to the county. Please feel free to contact the Fire Marshall with any questions at 801-540-7094.
