Winter Ordinances Reminder

Code 6.01.040(D):

No on-street parking from 12 midnight until 12 noon from November 1st through March 31st

Code 7.01.020(A):

Keep sidewalks clear of snow, sleet or hail

Other Reminders: Slow down in the school zones & watch for children & buses, get the snow blowers and plows serviced, check rain gutters & fireplace chimneys, and clear off sidewalks and 3 feet around fire hydrants.

DON'T FORGET:

It is unlawful for any person to deposit or blow snow, or any other material, onto the street!

Public notice is hereby given to inform residents of South Weber City that there will be a municipal general election on **November 7, 2017** for the following offices:

- 1 Mayoral position (4-year term)
- 2 At-Large City Council positions (4-year term)

If a primary election is needed, it will be held on August 15, 2017.

The constitutional and statutory qualification requirements for municipal office are:

- 1. The person is a registered voter in the municipality.
- 2. The person will be at least 18 years old at the time of the next election.
- 3. The person is a legal resident of the municipality for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
- 4. The person has not been convicted of a felony.

Interested parties may declare their candidacy for an office **in person between June 1 and June 7, 2017**, at City Hall, with the City Recorder, located at 1600 E. South Weber Dr., Monday - Friday between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM.



CODE ENFORCEMENT NOTES

Please do not push snow back into the roadways; if you're plowing it is not lawful to make walls that are in the roadway. Severe damage can happen to the plows and the trucks after the wall becomes a block of ice.


