

<u>Code 7.01.030(D)</u>: Keep all trees/bushes trimmed away from sidewalks.

<u>Code 6.01.040(D)</u>: No on street parking from 12 midnight - 12 noon from November 1 through March 31.

<u>Code 7.01.020(A)</u>: Keep sidewalks clear of snow, sleet or hail.

Slow down in the school zones and watch for children and buses, get the snow blowers and plows serviced, check rain gutters & fireplace chimneys.

Attention all Business Owners!!

If you have not received your 2016 business license renewal in the mail yet, you have either not paid or still need a fire inspection. If a fire inspection is necessary for your renewal, please schedule one by calling City Hall at 801-479-3177 ext. 201, 202, or 205.

Please be aware that a 50% penalty has now been assessed to the license fee for all business license renewals which have not been paid, and a 100% penalty will be assessed to the fee for any business license renewal which has not been paid by March 1st, 2016.
