

#### City Code Reminders!

#### <u>10.11.040(E)</u>

#### Parking In Front Yard Prohibited:

No portion of a front yard as required in this title, except driveways, shall be used for the parking of automobiles or other vehicles, unless developed as a public parking area in conjunction with a permitted commercial use, or as otherwise permitted in accordance with section 10.08.050 of this title.

#### <u>7.02.050</u>

**Mixing Concrete On Paved Streets Or** Sidewalks: Permit Unless a permit from the Public Works Director has been obtained... it shall be unlawful to place or pile or permit to be placed or piled, any sand, gravel, lime, cement, mortar, plaster, concrete or any like substance or mixture, or allow the same to remain on any portion of any paved street or sidewalk.
