Water Conservation Inside the Home



"It would be unwise for Utahns to take drinking water for granted. As our population increases so does the demand for water resources, treatment plants, and water delivery systems. Conservation is no longer just a good idea; it is absolutely necessary for the future success of our state."

Top things to do inside the home to conserve water:

- Install low flow shower heads, toilets & sink aerators
- Repair all leaks
- Install new appliances that use less water
- To check leaks in the toilet: put food coloring in the tank, if the color appears in the bowl without flushing there is a leak
- Find creative ways to not have to do so many dishes: Use 1 glass per person per day; if you wash dishes by hand, fill one basin with clean water for rinsing and a smaller basin or pot with soapy water instead of running the water.

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
Code Enforcement Notes
