The Tour of Utah cycling race will be coming through South Weber City on August 4, 2017. Traffic delays are to be expected. South Weber Drive will be closed from approximately 11:45 am -12:20 pm

<u>1250 East Project Update</u> – The new water line has been installed and connected into the City's water system. The secondary water service main line installation has been completed. Services from the secondary mainline are in the process of being installed and connected. The next phase following the secondary water line is the installation of a new storm drain system, and then asphalt to be followed soon thereafter. The 1250 East project is currently on schedule to be completed by the middle of August.

<u>Cottonwood Dr. Project</u> – Sections of Cottonwood Dr. are scheduled to undergo repairs at approx. the end of August from the Weber River Bridge and continuing around the bend. As the timeline for construction approaches more information will be made available on the City's website at southwebercity.com.

<u>I-84 Overcrossing</u> – In conjunction with the Cottonwood Dr. repair project, the I-84 Overcrossing from 475 East will commence repair following the Cottonwood Dr. repair project. Construction is tentatively scheduled for the beginning of September.

The City will have a few dumpsters placed around town to help get rid of trash and yard waste, not including chemicals or tires. Please contact Chris Tremea with Code Enforcement @ 801-540-7094 if you are interested in having a dumpster near your home. The program is starting soon.
