Transportation Utility Fund

On June 20, 2017, the South Weber City Council held a public hearing and adopted Resolution 17-26 and Resolution 17-27, establishing the Transportation Utility Fund and Fee. The Transportation Utility Fee was established as a means to equitably fund the continual operations and maintenance of all City owned public roads. The Transportation Utility Fund is a restricted fund with monies that are to be expended for the sole purpose of operations and maintenance of City owned public roads.

The adopted monthly rate structure is tiered commencing at \$5.00 this fiscal year, \$10.00 the following fiscal year, and \$15.00 for each subsequent fiscal year leading up to the 2027 year. The estimated total annual revenue from the fund for the first year is \$126,000; the second year \$252,000; and \$378,000 each year thereafter. A review of the fund and the associated fee will take place in the year 2022. Because the Transportation Utility Fee is established as a public utility service, it will be included to the monthly utility bill. The fee will be implemented with the July 2017 Utility Bill. Funds originating from the Transportation Utility Fee shall be expended in accordance with the priorities indicated in the South Weber City Streets Capital Facilities Plan, the current remaining service life of roads, and/or as directed by the South Weber City Council.

South Weber Country Fair Days Fireworks will be held at Central Park this year. Please make note of the change of venue from years past. Central park will need to be vacated by no later than 9:30PM on Saturday August 5th so please plan accordingly.

Greetings South Weber Residents,

The Tour of Utah Race is coming through South Weber City on August 4th, 2017. The Tour of Utah is a seven-day, international sporting event for some of the best professional cycling teams in the world. It is known worldwide as "America's Toughest Stage Race". Stage 5 of the race is 112 miles in length travelling through Davis County including the entire length of South Weber Drive starting from Ritter Drive in Riverdale and ending at Hwy 89 where the cyclists will proceed south on Hwy 89 into Layton. This race will cause some minor traffic delays as South Weber Drive, and Southbound Highway 89 will be closed to all traffic during the race. This includes all side streets that access South Weber Drive for approximately 20 minutes until all racers pass through. Preplanned emergency services have been arranged in order to respond if needed. South Weber City Staff, Public Works, Racing Staff and Course Marshalls, Volunteers, Utah Highway Patrol, and Davis County Sheriff Deputies will have well marked closure of streets using barricades, cones, police tape, and personnel. Please do not cross the barriers put into place because doing so will significantly endanger the cyclists that are trusting that the road is clear of traffic as they zip by. South Weber Fire Department Announcements

We would like to encourage everyone to become familiar with the Recreational Fire Guidelines. All fires must have a responsible person of at least 18 years old or older, fires must not be larger than 3 feet in diameter, an approved fire extinguishing agent must be onsite, no fires shall be conducted within 25 feet of a structure including the removal of any conditions that may contribute to fire spread. The South Weber Fire Department reserves the right to order a fire to be extinguished at any time and it is advised that you notify the fire department that you are having a recreational fire. FIREWORKS!!

There will be a strict **NO** fireworks ban from everywhere EAST of Highway 89 as well as the following areas: There is an Aerial fireworks ban everywhere South of Deer Run Drive to 1900 East, West of 1900 E. to 7600 S, South of 7600 S. 1550 E, South of 7500 S to 1075 E, from that point at 1075 East there will be no aerial fireworks anywhere South of South Weber Drive. Please enjoy your fireworks season and remember the Safety is no accident. Fireworks injuries are no laughing matter and will/may leave you and your family with lifelong reminders. Fireworks may only be lit 3 days before and 3 days after the 4th and 24th of July. Please contact 911 if there is an emergency!! Fires spread rapidly so contact us quickly. Please see the City Website or our Fire Department Facebook page for a visual map of an aerial fireworks ban and they will also be posted at any local fireworks stands.

Code Enforcement Notes

We would like to remind everyone about the parking restrictions on the roadway and to make sure that you are not parking large vehicles, trailers, or construction equipment on the roadways.

If your properties are vacant, or you just have a lot that is continuously a haven for weeds, please get them taken care of immediately. You can use a general rule of thumb that if the weeds are any higher than your knees then a citation will be issued. Since we are on the subject of weeds, if your trailer or vehicle is parked in the weeds it will be deemed a fire hazard and you will be told to move the vehicle and/or take care of the fire hazard.

Country fair days is just around the corner and we are excited to get the party started. There are many of us that enjoy the companionship of our furry friends, but for the safety of others please leave the 4 legged ones at home. The Code Enforcement Officer and Animal Control will be present at all of the activities to ensure that the City and County Animal ordinances are kept.

There are many that take more time than others to solve but I can ensure you that progress is being made. We have had good snowpack and runoff this year. Then we hit 90-degree weather quicker than usual. The weather has been unique for sure! We ask that you water at the most, once every 3 days throughout the summer. This will encourage your lawn's roots to go deeper and you won't overwater. As things cool off again, around Labor Day, adjust your watering schedule to once every 5 days since your landscaping won't need as much. We encourage you to shut off sprinklers when it rains; just skipping one watering cycle saves thousands of gallons.
