**Agenda Item:** Crosswalks & Speed Limit Signs Discussion

**Background:** The City has recently received resident requests to place crosswalks or flashing speed limit signs in a few locations throughout the City, with residents even offering to pay for the signs themselves. The Public Safety Committee would like to have a discussion with the entire Council regarding whether residents should be involved in paying for these items.

Typical speed limit sign requests, without flashing lights, are evaluated by City staff and, when deemed appropriate, are placed at no cost to residents. Signs with flashing lights are much more expensive. Staff requires direction from Council on whether residents should participate in the cost when they are requested.

The City can determine where crosswalks are placed throughout the City, unless the road is State-owned, such as South Weber Drive. Additionally, regular crosswalks are slightly different than "school crossings", which also include flashing lights, a crossing guard at certain times of the day, and inclusion on the school's safe routes to school plan. School crossings on South Weber Drive are also handled by the State, except the City still provides the crossing guard.
