



Snow Removal

As the winter season approaches, we would like to remind you of our snow removal practices to ensure everyone's safety on the roads. Starting November 1st, winter parking rules will be in effect, and parking on the streets will not be allowed from midnight until noon. This is essential for our snow plows to clear roads efficiently and safely.

In addition to keeping vehicles off the streets, please ensure that trees along the roadways are trimmed. Overgrown branches can damage our snow removal equipment, which can delay service. Additionally, please be mindful of shoveling sidewalks, especially for children walking to school. Keeping sidewalks clear of snow and ice is crucial for everyone's safety.

Remember snow should not be shoveled or blown back into the street. This can create hazards and make it harder for plows to maintain safe roads.

Replacement Garbage Can Fees

Beginning October 1st, South Weber residents will see a fee of \$65 for replacing damaged garbage cans. This fee will not apply to lost cans, only those that are damaged and need replacement.

This change comes as Robinson Waste, our service provider, charges the city for each replacement can. To cover these costs, we need to pass this fee along to residents.

We understand the importance of keeping costs manageable, and we appreciate your understanding as we work to balance providing quality services with necessary expenses. If your garbage can is damaged and needs to be replaced, or if you have any questions, please contact the city offices for assistance.
