## Elections

Public Notice is hereby given to inform residents of South Weber City that there will be a municipal general election on November 5, 2019 for the following offices:

3 At-Large City Council positions (4-year term)

If a primary election is needed, it will be held on August 13, 2019.

The constitutional and statutory qualification requirements for municipal office are:

1. The person is a registered voter in the municipality.
2. The person will be at least 18 years old at the time of the next election.
3. The person is a legal resident of the municipality for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
4. The person has not been convicted of a felony.

Interested parties may declare their candidacy for an office in person between June 3 and June 7, 2019, at City Hall with the City Recorder located at 1600 E. South Weber Dr., Monday—Friday between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm.

## Fire Department

As the weather warms up, we want to remind everyone of our guidelines for Recreational Fires.

Recreational Fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material. Conditions which could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.

Open burning/recreational fires shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished. A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher with a maximum 4-A rating or other approved onsite fire extinguishing equipment, such as dirt, sand, water barrel, garden hose, or water truck shall be available for immediate utilization.

Fire must not be larger than 3 ft in diameter.

Burning material other than firewood, charcoal briquettes, propane or L.P. gas is prohibited.

***South Weber Fire Department reserves the right to order a fire to be extinguished at any time.***

## Code Enforcement

Somebody recently took it upon themselves to dump their trash along our river access area. This is illegal and extremely dangerous. If you happen to see someone doing this, please contact Davis County Sheriffs Office immediately. With this particular incident and with the help of public works, code enforcement, and the sheriff's office, many items were retrieved to help locate this non-law abiding citizen.

Please help us keep South Weber clean and get nuisance items off of your own properties. This includes trash piles, clippings, non-running vehicles, or any other item that is not in line with City code.

New subdivisions are being built all over South Weber and what used to be an empty field, could now be someone's backyard. The deadline for removing nuisance vehicles ends shortly and all cases are going to citation immediately. This was announced in November of last year, giving plenty of notice to get these vehicles removed.

## Friendly Reminders

-As the weather improves, please be aware of pedestrians and obey all local traffic signs!

Please keep pets on a leash at all times whether you are walking them at 5 am or 5 pm.

All sidewalks shall be kept clear and unobstructed to a height of seven feet. No vegetation shall be allowed to extend into the street past the curb face of the edge of the pavement where there is no curb to a height of less than fourteen feet.
