SOUTH WEBER WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT CUSTOMERS

Dear Customers,

The South Weber Water Improvement District greatly appreciates the efforts made by its customers last year by following the watering guidelines and doing their best to conserve our valuable water. Due to the statewide drought situation, the following watering guidelines and restrictions will be in place this coming season.

- Water will be turned on **May 15, 2022** and will be shut off mid-September or when we run out of our contracted amount of water, whichever comes first.
- Customers may water **twice per week with one water cycle**. A water cycle equals 20-minutes for spray nozzles and 40-minutes for rotors.
- **Odd numbered houses may water Monday and Thursday**
- **Even numbered houses may water Tuesday and Friday**
- Agricultural Users/Farmers need to reduce usage by 20%
- NO watering on Wednesday, Saturday, or Sunday
- **Do not water between 10 AM and 6 PM**
- Please mow your lawn at its highest mower setting
- Mulch your grass clippings – they will help decrease evaporation
- Aerating your lawn will improve its drought resiliency.
