Their goal is to have the "sweeping T" curb and gutter, and pavement finished on 475 E. by the end of September. We'll keep our fingers crossed! UDOT is also moving along with the mill and overlay on South Weber Drive. The project is taking longer than expected because of the many soft spots UDOT has run into and had to patch. ## Reminders

Now that school has started, South Weber City asks that residents please follow these 4 tips in helping to keep our children safe:

Be patient as you drop off and pick up your children at the Lester Dr. and 1250 E Intersection.

Be attentive to all crosswalks, the crossing guards, and the flashing crosswalk street lights.

Observe the 20-mph speed limit when crosswalk lights are flashing.

PLEASE do not text or use any form of electronic device in or around any school zone.

## Code Enforcement Notes

Please keep your trees, bushes, and other plants off the sidewalk to a height of 7 feet and at least 14 feet above the curb or street. During the winter, the branches tend to be weighed down and fall below that 14-foot requirement. Please take care of this while the weather is warm.

Having trees, weeds, bushes, or other debris overlap a sidewalk can be very dangerous for those that like to exercise using the safety of the sidewalks. When there is not enough passage along the sidewalk, it forces pedestrians into the roadway. Warnings and/or citations will be issued for obstructed sidewalks. Please do not allow landscapers to place boulders, rocks, or dirt over the sidewalk or on any portion of the roadway; you, as the homeowner, will be responsible for any damage to the roadways or sidewalks caused by landscapers.

Please keep in mind that all premises shall have permanently attached address numbers plainly visible and legible from any public access. The numbers shall be a minimum of three inches (3") and be a color that contrasts with the background. Any premises that are concealed from the public access must post the address in a location visible from public access.
